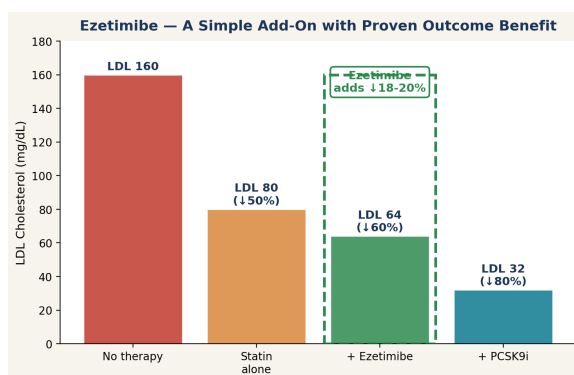


Understanding Ezetimibe (Zetia)

The simple non-statin add-on with proven heart benefit

One pill, 10 mg, a day. Drops LDL another 18 to 20%. IMPROVE-IT proved it cuts heart attacks and strokes.

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Names & Terms You Will Hear

Term	Meaning
Zetia (ezetimibe)	The brand and generic names. The cheap generic has been sold since 2016.
NPC1L1 inhibitor	The drug class name. NPC1L1 is a gate in your gut that lets cholesterol into your blood. Ezetimibe shuts the gate.
Vytorin (simvastatin + ezetimibe)	One pill that holds both drugs.
Roszet (rosuvastatin + ezetimibe)	One pill that pairs a stronger statin with ezetimibe.
Non-statin lipid therapy	Drugs that lower LDL but are not statins. Ezetimibe is the one used most.
IMPROVE-IT	A large 2015 trial (Cannon, NEJM). It proved that adding ezetimibe to a statin cuts heart attacks and strokes. It enrolled 18,144 people and tracked them for 7 years.



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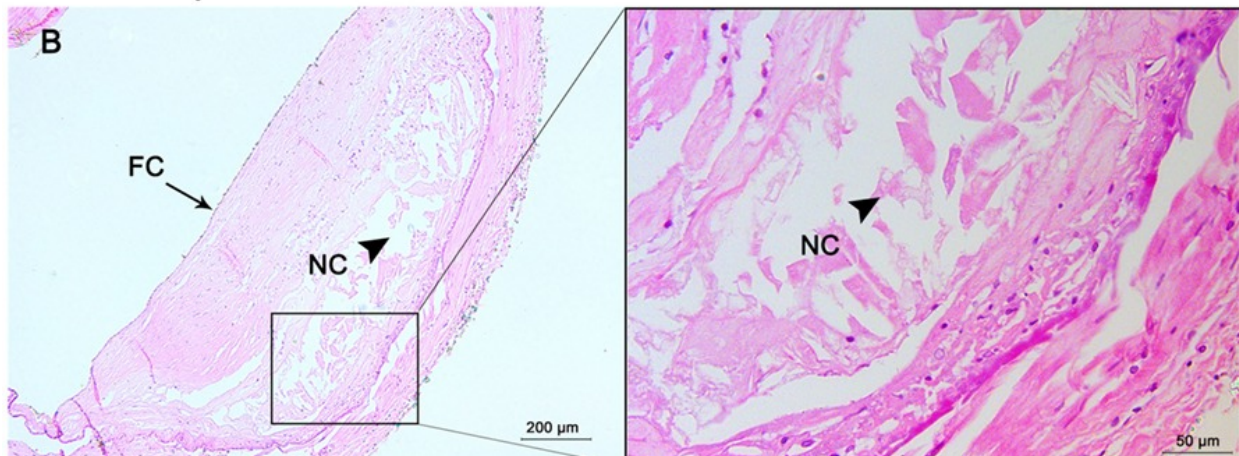


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What Is Ezetimibe (Zetia)?

- Ezetimibe is a once-a-day pill that lowers LDL (your 'bad' cholesterol). It blocks how your gut takes in cholesterol — both from food and from bile made by your liver.
- Your gut has a gate called NPC1L1. It lets cholesterol into your blood. Ezetimibe shuts this gate. Your body then takes in about half as much cholesterol.
- **Added to a statin**, ezetimibe drops LDL an extra 18 to 20%. That is about the same drop you get by doubling your statin dose — but with far fewer side effects.
- The dose is one 10 mg pill a day. Take it any time, with or without food. Combo pills like **Vytorin** (simvastatin + ezetimibe) and **Roszet** (rosuvastatin + ezetimibe) put both drugs in one tablet.
- Generic ezetimibe has been off-patent since 2016. It tends to cost \$5 to \$30 a month with insurance, and \$10 to \$15 with a discount card.

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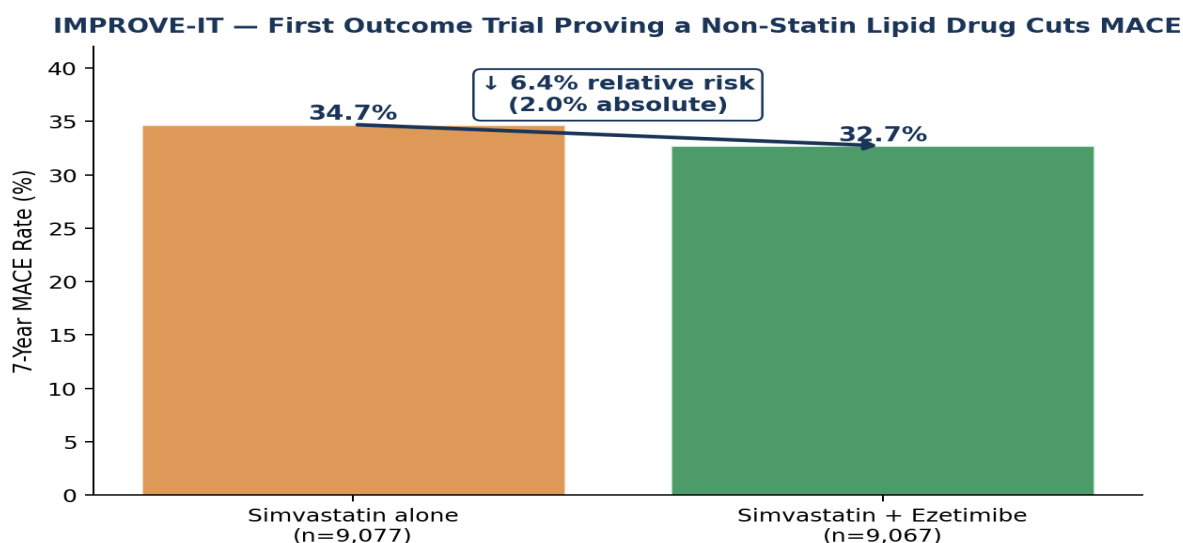
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Why It Matters

- **IMPROVE-IT (Cannon, NEJM 2015)** was the **FIRST** big trial to prove a non-statin LDL drug cuts heart attacks and strokes. It added ezetimibe to a statin in 18,144 people after a heart attack. Over 7 years, heart attacks, strokes, and deaths dropped 6.4% (a 2.0% drop in plain terms).
- This trial backed the 'add-on' plan. If your statin alone does not get your LDL low enough, adding a second drug — rather than just living with the risk — lowers your odds of a heart attack.
- Ezetimibe is the **cheapest and easiest-to-take** non-statin add-on. In trials, side effects were about the same as a sugar pill.
- It is a key rung on the LDL-lowering ladder: **start with a statin, then add ezetimibe, then add a PCSK9 shot or inclisiran**. Most people hit their goal at the ezetimibe rung.
- If statins do not agree with you, ezetimibe on its own is a fair choice (about an 18% LDL drop by itself).
- If you have a high-cholesterol gene problem (called FH), ezetimibe is the standard add-on after a statin.



Cannon NEJM 2015 (n=18,144 ACS patients). Primary endpoint: CV death, MI, unstable angina req hospitalization, coronary revasc, stroke.

IMPROVE-IT (Cannon, NEJM 2015; 18,144 people after a heart attack). Adding ezetimibe to a statin cut the 7-year rate of heart attacks, strokes, and deaths from 34.7% to 32.7%. That is a 6.4% drop (2.0% in plain terms). It was the first trial to prove a non-statin LDL drug helps this way.



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IMPROVE-IT changed the field. Until 2015, many believed the heart benefit of lowering LDL came only from statins. IMPROVE-IT (Cannon, NEJM 2015) showed that was wrong. Adding ezetimibe to a statin cut heart attacks and strokes BEYOND what the statin did alone. That one trial reset the way we treat cholesterol. Now every guideline says to 'add a non-statin' when a statin alone does not get a higher-risk patient to goal.



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Treatment Options

- **Usual dose:** one 10 mg pill by mouth, once a day. There is no dose to ramp up.
- **Timing:** any time of day, with or without food. Most people take it when they take their statin — morning or night.
- **Combo pills:** Vytorin (simvastatin + ezetimibe) and Roszet (rosuvastatin + ezetimibe) hold both drugs in one tablet. One pill is easier to keep up with.
- **With cholesterol binders:** if you take cholestyramine or colesevelam, they soak up ezetimibe. Take ezetimibe at least 2 hours before, or 4 hours after, those drugs.
- **With cyclosporine:** this drug raises ezetimibe levels a lot. If you take it, talk with your heart doctor and your transplant team.
- **Lab check:** get a new lipid panel about 4 to 12 weeks after you start. Look for an extra 18 to 20% LDL drop on top of your statin.
- **If statins do not agree with you:** ezetimibe on its own (10 mg) gives about an 18% LDL drop. That is a fair first step before you move up to bempedoic acid or a PCSK9 shot.



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The LDL-Lowering Ladder — Where Ezetimibe Fits

Step	Therapy	Additional LDL Drop	Cost / Notes
1	Lifestyle (Mediterranean/DASH, weight, exercise)	5-15%	Free; foundation
2	Low-intensity statin	20-30%	Generic; pennies/month
3	High-intensity statin (atorva 40-80 / rosuva 20-40)	45-55%	Generic; cheap
4	Add Ezetimibe 10 mg	+18-20%	Generic; \$5-30/month
5	Add Bempedoic acid 180 mg	+15-20%	Brand; \$400-600/month
6	Add PCSK9i (Repatha/Praluent/Leqvio)	+50-60%	Brand; insurance + copay card



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How Ezetimibe Works — The Gut Gate

- **Where cholesterol comes from:** only about a quarter of your cholesterol comes from food. Your liver makes the rest. The liver sends some out in bile, then takes much of it back in. So the same cholesterol is used again and again.
- **The gut gate:** a gate called NPC1L1 sits on the cells that line your gut. It pulls cholesterol into your blood — both from food and from bile.
- **What ezetimibe does:** it shuts this gate. Your gut then takes in about half as much cholesterol — both from your meals and from the bile your liver makes.
- **Why this matters:** with less cholesterol coming in, your liver pulls more LDL out of your blood to make up for it. The result: LDL drops about 18 to 20% on top of whatever else you take.
- **Why it teams up with statins:** a statin blocks the cholesterol your body MAKES. Ezetimibe blocks the cholesterol your gut TAKES IN. Two different jobs, so the drops add up.
- **Why side effects are few:** the gate mainly handles cholesterol. So ezetimibe does not get in the way of vitamins A, D, E, and K, or other nutrients.

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Risks, Benefits, and Alternatives

Every choice has trade-offs. Use this table to start the shared decision conversation.

Option	Risks	Benefits	Alternatives
Add ezetimibe to your statin	Mild gut upset (about 3%) that most often fades. It can clash with cyclosporine and cholesterol binders.	An extra 18 to 20% LDL drop. Proven to cut heart attacks (IMPROVE-IT). Cheap. One pill a day. Easy to take.	Raise the statin dose (some people do not tolerate this), bempedoic acid (newer, costs more), a PCSK9 shot (works better but is a shot).
Switch from a lone statin to a combo pill (Vytorin or Roszet)	Same side effects as each drug alone. Cost may run higher than two generics.	One pill is easier to keep up with. Same results as taking the two drugs apart.	Keep taking ezetimibe and a statin as two separate generic pills (often cheaper).
Ezetimibe alone (for people who cannot take statins)	Only about an 18% LDL drop by itself. May not reach goal in higher-risk people.	A good first non-statin choice. Easy to take. Cheap. Some LDL drop beats none.	Bempedoic acid (Nexletol — also a non-statin pill). A PCSK9 shot (works better).
Skip ezetimibe and go straight to a PCSK9 shot	A PCSK9 drug means shots, insurance sign-off, and a much higher cost. It skips the easy step.	The biggest LDL drop. Strong proof it helps. A good fit for very-high-risk people.	Add ezetimibe first as the cheap, easy step. Move up to a PCSK9 shot if you are still above goal.
No extra LDL drug (just your top statin dose)	If your LDL stays above goal, your heart risk stays higher.	A simpler plan. No added cost.	Add ezetimibe — the easiest next step.



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Common Misconceptions

Myth	Reality
Ezetimibe is a 'sugar pill' because it is not a statin.	Not true. The 2015 IMPROVE-IT trial was the FIRST to prove a non-statin LDL drug cuts heart attacks and strokes. It tracked 18,144 people for 7 years. Events dropped 6.4%. That is real.
If statins did not work for me, ezetimibe will not either.	These drugs work in different spots. Statins block cholesterol your liver MAKES. Ezetimibe blocks cholesterol your gut TAKES IN. People who cannot take a statin often do fine on ezetimibe.
Ezetimibe causes muscle pain like statins.	Mostly no. In trials, muscle pain was about as common as with a sugar pill. The muscle aches that make people quit statins do NOT come from ezetimibe.
If I take ezetimibe I can eat whatever I want.	No drug can stand in for a good diet. Ezetimibe blocks about half of the cholesterol in your food. But a diet very high in cholesterol still floods past the drug. The best plan is healthy eating plus ezetimibe plus a statin.
Ezetimibe is too cheap to work.	Cost has nothing to do with how well a drug works. Generic ezetimibe at \$10 to \$30 a month gives the same 18 to 20% LDL drop as the first Zetia brand.
Vytorin works better than two separate pills.	Same drugs, same result. The only edge Vytorin has is ease — one pill, not two. If you take both pills on time, the two-pill route is often cheaper.
I should wait until I have a heart attack before I add ezetimibe.	No. If your LDL stays above goal on your top statin dose, AND you have heart disease or a high-cholesterol gene problem, you should add ezetimibe NOW — not after the next event.



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Possible Complications

Knowing what can go wrong helps you spot problems early. Most complications are uncommon, especially with treatment.

Where / What	What Can Happen
Mild gut upset (about 3%)	You may get some diarrhea, belly pain, or an upset stomach. It most often fades. If it sticks around, try taking the pill with food or at a different time.
Muscle pain (rare)	Muscle aches go up just a little over a sugar pill. That is far less than with statins. If your muscles hurt on a statin plus ezetimibe, the statin is the likely cause.
Liver problem (rare, under 1%)	Liver tests may go up a little for a short time. A bad liver problem is very rare. You do not need routine liver tests for ezetimibe by itself. (Statins can be a different story.)
Muscle breakdown (very rare, with statins)	This is very rare. The risk comes from the statin, not from ezetimibe. On its own, ezetimibe does not harm muscle.
Drugs that can clash with it	Cyclosporine raises ezetimibe levels. Take care if you had a transplant. Cholesterol binders (cholestyramine, colestevlam) soak up ezetimibe. Take them 2 to 4 hours apart from it.
Gallstones (very rare)	There is a small chance in theory, since the drug changes how bile moves cholesterol. Trials saw no real rise.



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Points to Know

If you remember nothing else, remember these key points.

- Ezetimibe drops LDL about 18 to 20% on top of a statin.
- IMPROVE-IT proved it cuts heart attacks and strokes. It was the first non-statin LDL drug to show this.
- One pill a day, by mouth, 10 mg. No dose to ramp up. Take it any time.
- Generic and cheap (\$5 to \$30 a month).
- Combo pills (Vytorin, Roszet) make it easier to keep up with.
- Side effects feel about the same as a sugar pill. No muscle aches.
- It is the standard next step after a statin if your LDL stays above goal.
- If you cannot take statins, you can use ezetimibe on its own (about an 18% LDL drop).



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When to Call Us - and When to Call 911

If you are not sure, call. We would rather hear from you twice than miss a real problem.

- Belly pain that will not go away, mostly on the upper right side — call us this week (gallstones are rare but can happen).
- Muscle weakness you cannot explain, or dark urine — call us today (a muscle problem is very rare, and comes from the statin you take with it).
- Marked tiredness, yellow skin or eyes, or upper-right belly pain — call us this week (a liver problem is rare).
- A bad allergic reaction (hives, swelling, trouble breathing) — call 911.
- Planning to get pregnant, or a new pregnancy — call us. We do not know if ezetimibe is safe in pregnancy, so we most often stop it.
- Bad diarrhea or belly cramps — call us this week.
- No new lipid panel by 6 to 12 weeks after you start — call to set one up.
- Thinking of stopping over cost — call us first. Generic forms and discount cards are usually easy to get.
